




## Taking a photograph of your wound

Your doctor or nurse may ask you to take photographs of your wound to help monitor progress.



## 5 tips for taking a good photo

- Keep the background clutter free
- Move distracting items such as jewellery
- Take the photo from above
- Take photos at different angles too
- Take photos far away and then close up to help spot if a wound is getting worse
