Why should you take a photograph of your wound?



## **Clinical reasons**

- To help a doctor or nurse to assess your wound and provide the right treatment
- To see how the wound changes over time
- To help if you see a different doctor or nurse
- To help spot if a wound is getting worse



## **Personal reasons**

- Peace of mind
- So that you can see how your wound is changing
- It may be more convenient as you may not need to travel to the clinic or surgery
